Solicitor and the said Charles Woodhouse and
James (hereinafter referred to as "the Fellows Trustees")

Durham Clerk in Holy Order the said Tom James
and Lionel Richard Stopford Sackville
of Spurways Hormonden in the County of Kent a colonel
in His Majesty's Army Retired (all of whom are hereinafter
referred to as "the Stopford Sackville Trustees") of the
sixth part Frederick Woodhouse James of 33
Churton Street Westminster in the County of London
Lieutenant Colonel (retired) of His Majesty's Army and

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the said Charles Woodhouse James (who
are together hereinafter referred to as "the James Trustees")
of the seventh part Henry Nicholas Middleton
of the City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne Banker
and George Anthony Fenwick of the same place
Banker (together hereinafter referred to as "the mortgagees")
of the eighth part the said Christian Hugh,
Septimus James of the ninth part and The
Reverend Richard Burdon of Heddon House
in the County of Northumberland Clerk in Holy Orders
of the tenth part.

Whereas these presents are supplemental to the
deeds mentioned and specified in the First Schedule
hereunder written.

And whereas under or by virtue of the Will and Codicil
of Thomas James mentioned in the first part of the said
first schedule the tithes rent charge hereinafter described
and the lands and hereditaments comprised and described
in the Second Schedule hereunder written are vested in
the said Charles Woodhouse James as Trustee subject
nevertheless to the mortgage and charge hereinafter
referred to.

And whereas the said Charles Woodhouse James is
beneficially seised of or otherwise entitled in fee simple in
possession to one undivided fourth part or share and
the said Tom James is beneficially seised of or otherwise
entitled in fee simple in possession to one undivided
eighth part or share of and in the said tithes rent charge
subject nevertheless to the mortgage for three thousand
five hundred pounds hereinafter referred to) and of and

in the said lands and hereditaments

And whereas under or by virtue of the deeds documents
and events mentioned and specified in the first part of
the said first schedule the said Christian Hugh
Septimus James is beneficially entitled in fee simple in
possession to one other undivided fourth part or share
of and in the said title rent charge (subject nevertheless
to the said mortgage for Three thousand five hundred
pounds hereinafter referred to) and of and in the said lands
and hereditaments subject nevertheless to a charge on such
one fourth part or share in favour of the James Trustees
for securing the payment to them as the present Trustees
of the marriage settlement of the said Christian Hugh
Septimus James of the sum of Four thousand pounds.

And whereas the hereinbefore recited charge of Four
thousand pounds in favour of the James Trustees was
originally for the sum of Five thousand pounds but on the
sale in the year one thousand
of certain other property also subject to the said charge the
whole of the purchase money arising from such sale
amounting to the sum of One thousand pounds was paid
to the James Trustees thereby reducing their charge to the
said sum of Four thousand pounds.

And whereas under or by virtue of the deeds and events
mentioned and specified in the second part of the said
first schedule the beneficial interest in the one undivided
fourth part or share of and in the said title rent charge
(subject nevertheless to the said mortgage for Three
thousand five hundred pounds hereinafter referred to) and
of and in the said lands and hereditaments which Emily

Hope Fellows mentioned in the said Will of Thomas James became entitled to thereunder is now vested in the Fellows Trustees upon certain trusts for sale thereof.

And whereas under or by virtue of the deed mentioned and specified in the third part of the said first schedule the beneficial interest in the one undivided eighth part or share of and in the said tithe rent charge (subject nevertheless to the said mortgage for three thousand five hundred pounds hereinafter referred to) and of and in the said lands and hereditaments which the said Mr. Stopford Sackville became entitled to under the said Will of the said Thomas James is now vested in the Stopford Sackville Trustees upon certain trusts for sale thereof at the request in writing of Mr. Stopford Sackville.

And whereas under or by virtue of the deeds documents and events mentioned and specified in the fourth part of the said first schedule the tithe rent charge hereinafter described and intended to be hereby granted is now vested in the mortgagee by way of mortgage for securing the repayment to them of the sum of Three thousand five hundred pounds all interest thereon having been paid to the date of these presents.

And whereas the persons parties hereto of the first six parts have agreed with the said Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon for the sale to them of the said tithe rent charge lands and hereditaments and the fee simple thereof in no session free from incumbrances at the price of Twenty five thousand five hundred pounds and it has been arranged that such conveyance of portions thereof should be made to the said Christian

Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon respectively
as is hereinafter contained.

From this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance
of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of
Three thousand five hundred pounds on the execution
of these presents paid to the mortgagees by the said
Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon
at the request and by the direction of the said persons
parties hereto of the first ~~two~~ parts respectively (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) the mortgagees hereby
at the request and by the direction aforesaid and as
mortgagees grant and release and the said Charles
Woodhouse James as to the entirety of the said tithe
rent charge doth hereby as trustee of the Will of the
said Thomas James grant and convey and the fellow
Trustees as to one equal undivided fourth part or share
of and in the said tithe rent charge do hereby as Trustees
grant and convey and the said Charles Woodhouse
James as to one other undivided fourth part or share of
and in the said tithe rent charge doth hereby as beneficial
owner grant and convey and the James Trustees as to
one other undivided fourth part or share of and in the said
tithe rent charge at the request of the said Christian Hugh
Septimus James do hereby release and the said Christian
Hugh Septimus James as to such last mentioned part or
share doth hereby as beneficial owner grant and convey
and the said Tom James as to one undivided eighth part
or share of and in the said tithe rent charge doth hereby
as beneficial owner grant and convey and the Stopford
Jackville Trustees as to one other undivided eighth part or

share of and in the said tithe rent charge as Trustees and
with the consent and by the direction of Mr. Stoppard Suckville
as beneficial owner do hereby grant and convey unto the
said Richard Burdon and his heirs

All that freehold tithe commutation rentcharge of One
hundred and fifty pounds sterling payable in lieu of tithes
arising out of the several lands within the township of
Rowchester otherwise Rudchester in the Parish of Cvingham
in the County of Northumberland and all other the estates
of the parties hereto of the first eight parts prior to the
said tithe rentcharge or in to or upon the said lands and
hereditaments of Rudchester or upon or against the owners
or occupiers for the time being thereof in respect of the said
tithe rent charge or any part thereof.

To hold the same tithe rent charge unto the said Richard
Burdon and his heirs To the use of the said Christian
Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon their heirs
and assigns free and absolutely discharged from all
right or equity of redemption and from all claims and
demands under or by virtue of the Indentures mentioned
and specified in the Fourth part of the First Schedule
hereto or any of them.

And this Indenture further Witnesseth that in
further pursuance of the said agreements and in consider-
ation of the sum of Twenty three thousand pounds
upon the execution of these presents paid by the said
Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon
in manner following that is to say the sum of Six
thousand pounds to the Fellow Trustees the sum of
Six thousand pounds to the said Charles Woodhouse

James the sum of Four thousand pounds to the James
Trustees at the request of the said Christian Hugh &
Septimus James the sum of One thousand pounds to the
said Christian Hugh Septimus James the sum of Three
thousand pounds to the said Tom James and the sum of
Three thousand pounds to the Stopford Sackville Trustees
(the receipt of which said sums respectively is hereby
respectively acknowledged and the said receipt of which
said sum of Four thousand pounds the James Trustees do
hereby acknowledge to be in full discharge of all claims by
them against the estate of the said Thomas James deceased)
the said Charles Woodhouse James as to the entirety of the
lands and hereditaments hereinafter described doth hereby
as Trustee of the Will of the said Thomas James grant
and convey and the Fellows Trustees as to one undivided
fourth part or share of and in the said lands and heredit-
aments do hereby as Trustee grant and convey and the
said Charles Woodhouse James as to one other undivided
fourth part or share of and in the said lands and heredit-
aments doth hereby as beneficial owner grant and convey
and the James Trustees as to one other undivided fourth
part or share of and in the said lands and hereditaments
at the request of the said Christian Hugh Septimus James
do hereby release and the said Christian Hugh Septimus
James as to such last mentioned part or share doth hereby
as beneficial owner grant and convey and the said Tom
James as to one undivided eighth part or share of and in
the said lands and hereditaments doth hereby as beneficial
owner grant and convey and the Stopford Sackville Trustees
as to one other undivided eighth part or share of and in the

said lands and hereditaments as Trustees and with the consent and by the direction of Mr. Stopford Sackville as beneficial owner do hereby grant and convey unto the said Richard Burdon and his heirs

Firstly the lands and hereditaments situate in the Township of Rudchester in the Parish of Ovingham in the County of Northumberland which are described in the first part of the second Schedule hereunder written and are also delineated on the plan hereto annexed and are therein surrounded with a red verge line

Secondly the lands and hereditaments also situate in the Township of Rudchester which are described in the second part of the second Schedule hereunder written and are also delineated on the plan hereto annexed and are thereon surrounded with a yellow verge line.

To hold the said lands and hereditaments hereinbefore granted to the said Richard Burdon and his heirs (subject nevertheless to the said livery charge hereinbefore expressed to be hereby granted and to the rights and remedies for securing payment thereof) as to the lands and hereditaments described in the first part of the second Schedule hereunder written To the use of the said Christian Hugh Septimus James his heirs and assigns and as to the lands and hereditaments described in the second part of the second Schedule hereunder written To the use of the said Richard Burdon his heirs and assigns

And the said Trustees hereby acknowledge the right of each of them the said Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon to production of the Indentures dated respectively the fifth June one thousand eight hundred

and seventy eight and eighteenth November one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine mentioned and specified in the first part of the first schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof.

And the Fellows Trustees hereby acknowledge the right of each of them the said Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon to production of the Indentures mentioned and specified in the second part of the First Schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof.

And the Stopford Sackville Trustees hereby acknowledge the right of each of them the said Christian Hugh Septimus James and Richard Burdon to production of the Indenture mentioned and specified in the third part of the first Schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof.

And the said Christian Hugh Septimus James hereby acknowledges the right of the said Richard Burdon to production of the Indentures mentioned and specified in the fourth part of the first schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof and hereby undertakes for the safe custody thereof.
